2006 Fleurie ‘Les Roches du Vivier’, Domaine Berrod

Top quality example of this popular Beaujolais cru – with the typical juicy Gamay fruit but underlying savoury tannins and a hint of smokiness

2004 Chateauneuf du Pape ‘Telegramme’, Brunier

The ‘junior’ wine of the renowned Domaine de Vieux Telegraphe, made for drinking younger. Ripe red fruits, a touch of spice, elegant and warming

A ‘mini’ Barolo at roughly half the price of that great Italian red – but with lots of that wine’s black fruit character and similar savoury tannins and hints of nuts and game
